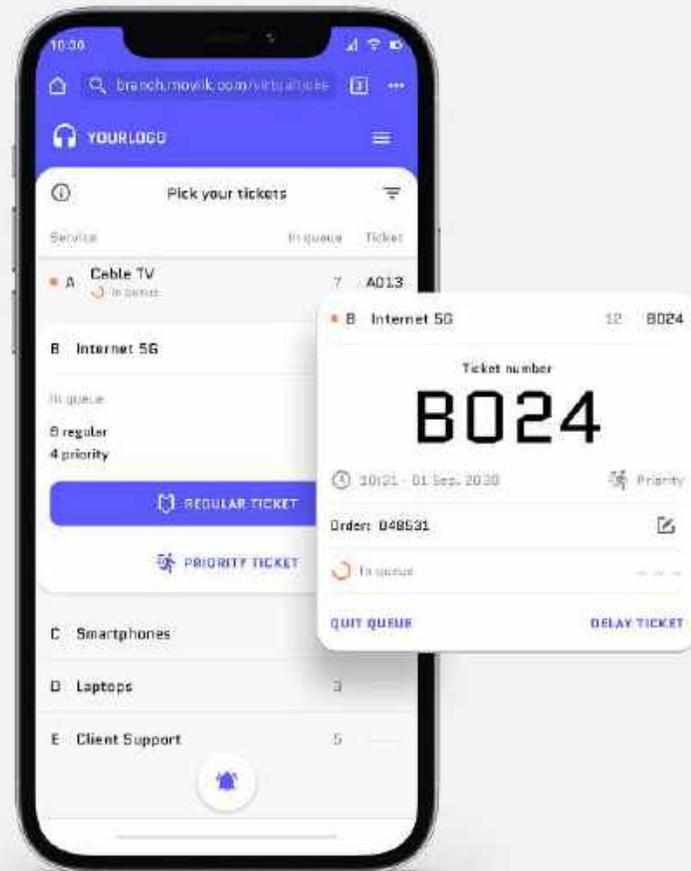

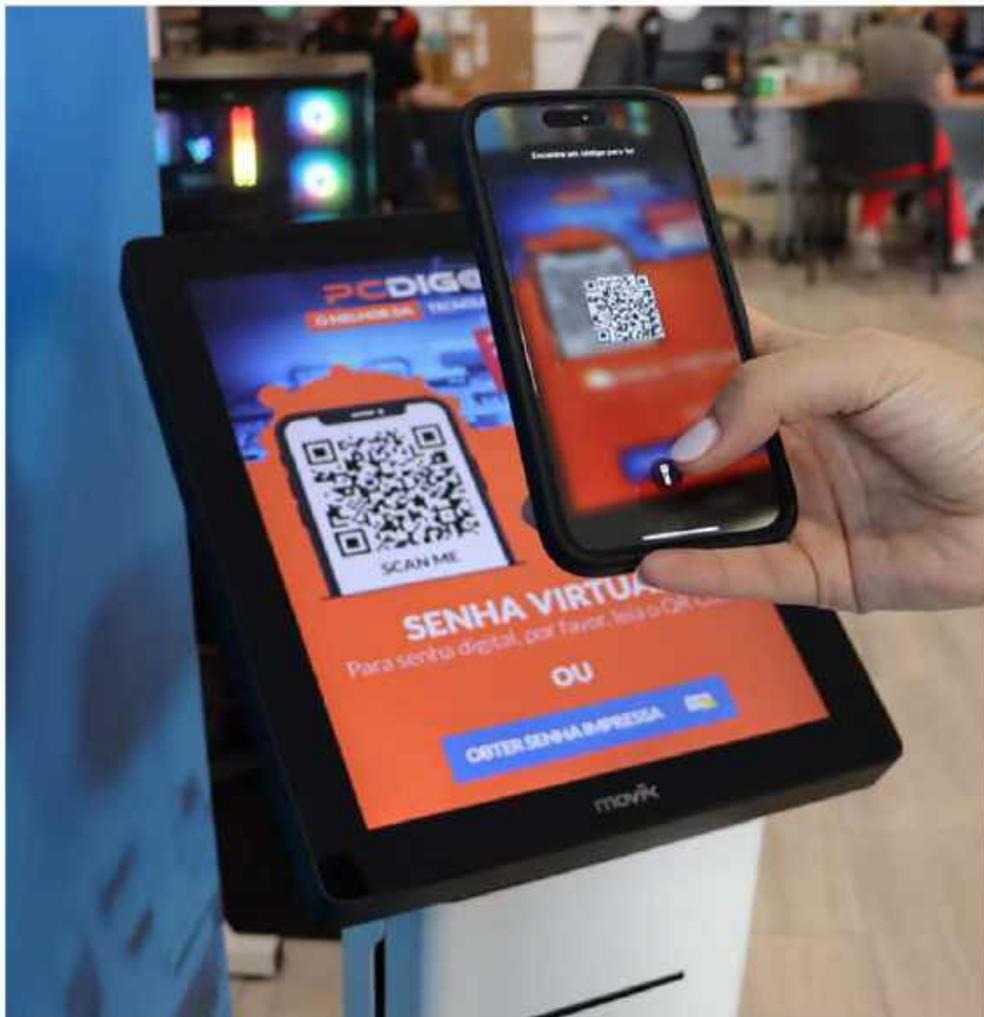

The rise of Digital and Remote Service

Organizations are rethinking how customers wait, move through service, and interact with staff, both on site and remotely.

73%

of customers abandon service if wait >5 min

78%

of customers prefer virtual queues over physical lines

41%

reduction in perceived wait with virtual queueing

Queues don't start and end at the kiosk

Modern service journeys combine physical and digital touchpoints in one flow

01 Get a ticket

Paper Ticket

Grab your ticket effortlessly, right from the kiosk.

Digital Ticket

Get your digital ticket instantly, anytime on your phone.

02 Wait your turn

Signage Player

Track the waitlist while you wait in-store.

SMS Notification

Be notified when your turn is near — be ready.

03 Get called

Signage Player

Announces the next customer in line with visual and audio feedback.

Digital Ticket

Get informed when your ticket is called and where to go.

SMS Notification

Get notified when it's your turn and know which counter to go.

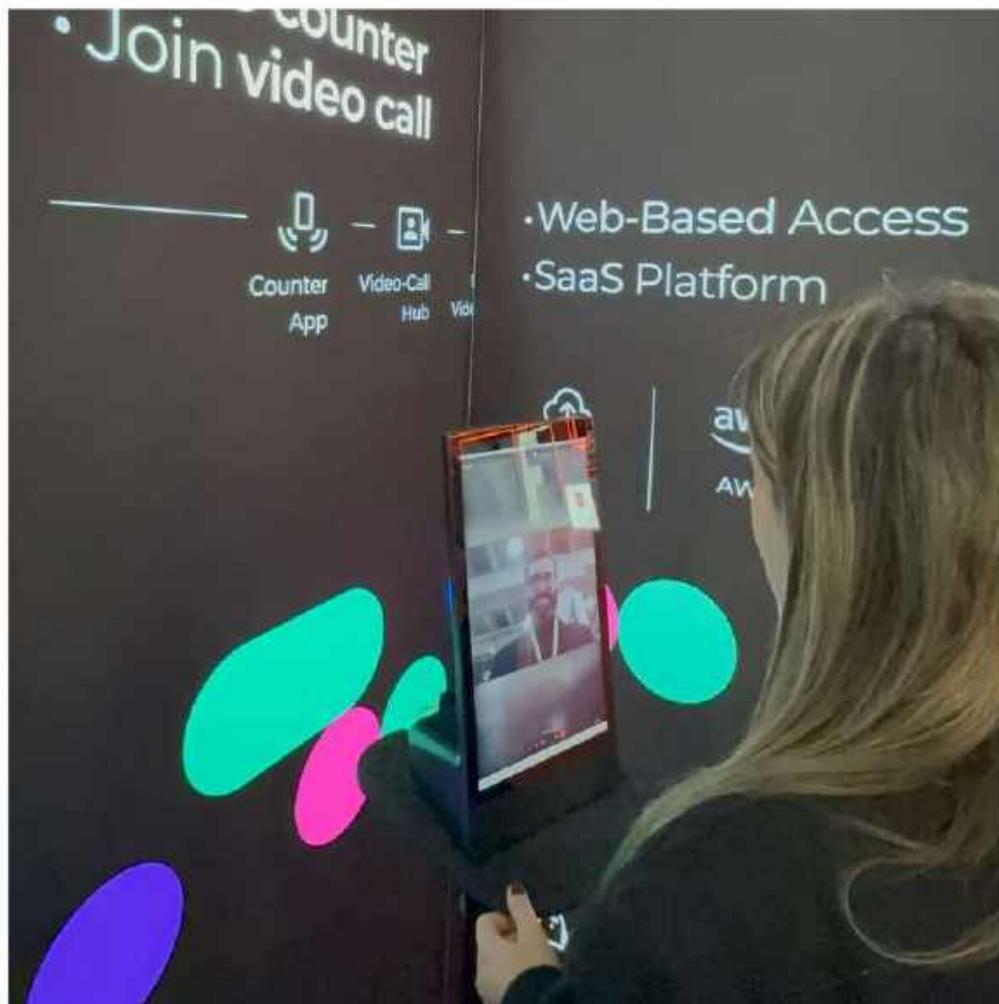
04 Get assistance

Counter

The calling app that lets store clerks direct the next customer to the counter.

Video-Call Hub

Allow your customers to be attended remotely for efficiency.



Video Attendance

Extend service capacity beyond physical counters while keeping everyone in the same queue flow.

Remote expert access

Connect customers with specialized staff without requiring them to be physically in the store.

Reduced waiting times

Balance demand across locations and teams by routing customers to available remote agents.

Better use of staff resources

Centralize expertise and support multiple branches from a single team.

Consistent service experience

Customers follow the same queue logic whether served locally or remotely.
